On behalf of the Arizona State Archery Association www.azarchery.com we would like to energetically endorse and support the development of the proposed Oro Valley archery field and courses. We believe that it is essential to provide nearby facilities for the public to enjoy a wide variety of activities for all ages such as target archery.

We understand that many that are unaware of what target archery is, and as a result, are hesitant to support it.

Here is some information helps to explain who target archers are and what we do.

- **Safety:** Safety is the number one focus of target archery. The Archery Trade Association has researched and published safety findings in the in the Insight publication V3/07 <http://www.archerytrade.org/images/documents/archerysafetyinsight.pdf> The research shows that archery is 10, 20 and even 30 time safer than sports like football, baseball, soccer and softball. Archery enjoys a safe record because of the structured safety education promoted by associations, clubs the National Archery In the Schools Program (NASP) and parents.
- **Park:** Today target archery is considered a park activity not primarily as a shooting sport. Recreational archery is peaceful, quiet and calm. Moms and dads bring their children to park archery for exercise and fun. Field courses can be described as a combination of a waterless golf course and hiking trails. Today archery fields are few and far between. Many must drive long distances for their archery. Community based archery parks allow residents to walk, bike or take a short drive to an archery park.
- **Youth Sport:** Youths are the focus of the future of archery. Archery is unique because of the need for both discipline and fitness. Many parents and children are attracted to archery because of the extra dimension of the mental determination beyond simply being quick or strong. NASP has certainly contributed to community members recognizing archery as a worthwhile activity. Archery brings youth outdoors whom might otherwise not take part in an outdoor sport.
- **Growth:** USA Archery, the US Olympic Committee sanctioned national governing body for Olympic and International competitive archery has researched the sports demographics and has found some interesting facts. The two groups age groups with the most target archery growth

are Masters age 50 and over and youth ages 12 to 16. The research indicated that the sport has been "neglected" in the 80s and early 90s and is on an upswing where more facilities, programs and equipment are in demand. The Masters class growth has been identified as a key source of archery teachers and mentors to run programs, instruct and teach.

- Sustainability: Archery in the southwest is unique as courses tend to be crush rock covered and require no irrigation or other utilities and no mowing or significant maintenance. Archery spaces are low cost to develop and maintain.
- Arizonans: Arizona has a sound archery legacy. Many youth, collegiate and world championship have benefited from Arizona archery support. Two major archery businesses are headquartered in Arizona (PSE and AAE). Top archers, coaches and leadership continue to live and work in Arizona. Arizona hosts the largest international tournament in the Americas, USA Archery Youth Camps and makes a variety of other top archery contributions. The Paseo Vista Archery facility in Chandler is an excellent example of a facility that is well used and serves a wide variety of "customers".

Lastly, the Arizona State Archery Association membership is eager to help with any design and operation input having helped to plan archery facilities around the country as volunteers and professionally. Many ASAA members work with Easton Foundations, ATA, AZGFD, PSE, AAE as well as continental and international associations. Please feel free to contact us with any questions or comments.
