

RESOLUTION NO. (R)15-59

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ORO VALLEY, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER TO PROCEED WITH THE PURCHASE OF 8.8 ACRES OF LAND LOCATED NEAR CANYON DEL ORO HIGH SCHOOL AND JAMES D. KRIEGH PARK FOR THE PURPOSE OF VARIOUS MUNICIPAL USES TO INCLUDE A POLICE SUBSTATION AND OTHER PUBLIC SAFETY OR RECREATIONAL RELATED USES

WHEREAS, the Town is interested in purchasing 8.8 acres of land located near Canyon Del Oro High School and James D. Kriegh Park which is currently owned by Amphitheater School District; and

WHEREAS, Amphitheater School District is willing to sell the parcel to the Town for \$265,000; and

WHEREAS, the parcel of land is being considered for various municipal uses to include a police substation, public safety related uses and recreational related uses to benefit both the Town and James D. Kriegh Park; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Town and its citizens to purchase the 8.8 acres of land located near James D. Kriegh Park and Canyon Del Oro High School for the price of \$265,000, plus minor related costs for the purpose of various municipal uses, including a police substation and other public safety or recreational uses;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Oro Valley, Arizona, that:

1. The Town Manager is authorized to take such steps as are necessary to purchase the 8.8 acres of land located near James D. Kriegh Park and Canyon Del Oro High School.
